Call to Participate in a Three Minutes Research Competition

1. Introduction

The Directorate of Postgraduate Studies, in collaboration with the DOCEHTA project, has organized a Three Minute Research Competition, designed to cultivate students' academic, presentation, and research communication skills. During the event, each participant will explain the breadth and significance of their research project to a non-specialist audience in not more than three minutes. The competition will take place in two rounds. Round 1 will take place at the Muhimbili University of Health and Allied Sciences and the University of Dodoma (UDOM) on June 5th, 2024. Round 2 will take place at UDOM on June 12th, 2024. This round will only involve three participants who will obtain the highest overall scores in round 1 from each of the two participating Universities. Interested PhD students are invited to participate **physically or virtually**.

2. Eligibility

PhD students of all disciplines who are registered at UDOM are eligible to participate in this competition.

3. Presentation Requirements and Guidelines

- A single static PowerPoint slide will be permitted.
- Presentations are to be spoken words (e.g. no poems, raps or songs).
- The decision of the panel of judges is final.

4. Judging Criteria

- A single static PowerPoint slide will be permitted.
- Presentations are to be spoken words (e.g. no poems, raps or songs).

5. Awards for the Winners

Round 1: Institutional Competition

- 1st Winner - TZS 500,000,
- 2nd Winner - TZS 400,000, and
- 3rd Winner - TZS 300,000

Round 2: Inter-University Competition

- Certificate of Performance
- 1st Winner - TZS 1,000,000,
- 2nd Winner - TZS 800,000, and
- 3rd Winner - TZS 600,000
