

Frequently Asked Questions Call for Scholarship - Research Scholarships on Migration and Forced Displacement in Sub-Saharan Africa

The following are the questions received up to 22nd May 2025 on the call above with the related answers.

I do know how to respond to the question, as well as which document I should upload to the question "Do you have the legal right to work in the country/countries where you would like to do your research?	Please respond yes if you are a citizen of the country you are interested in conducting your research in. You can attach any legal document showing you are a citizen of your chosen country. However, if you are not a citizen of any other country/countries, please attach a document showing you have a legal right to work in the country/countries
My name is I am filling out the application Google Form, BUT the system allows me to attach ID information only on page 4 out of 44, and then it jumps to the submission page 44. Other procedures/questions do not appear at all. Assist me, please.	The form leads you to the submission (i.e. to section 44) in case you select 'no' to the question 'Do you have the legal right to work in the country/countries where you would like to do your research?' The nationality or the legal right to work in the country (where it is suggested to conduct the research) are among the minimum criteria. If the applicant is not a national citizen of the selected country or does not have the right to carry out the research in the selected country are not eligible for the call. Please respond yes if you are a citizen of the country you are interested in conducting your research in. You can attach any legal document showing you are a citizen of any other country. However, if you are not a citizen of any other country/countries, please attach a document showing you have a legal right to work in the country/countries

Please review the advertisement for preferred areas of specialisation. However, you are welcome to apply if you are interested in researching migration and forced displacement
I would like to know if I need to translate my transcripts into English as well before submitting my application for the MAPS scholarship. I'm from a French-speaking country.	The evaluation will be done in English. Therefore, it is important to translate your certificate and proposal into English. It is also important to ensure the original and translated certificates are uploaded before submitting your application.
I am writing to ask for clarification on the need to have a letter of support from a supervisor at a university or research institution, as indicated in the call. Who is defined as a supervisor in this case? HOD, DVC-ARC, Principal, any senior researcher in my college, faculty?"	A supervisor refers to someone who supervised your research work at any level.
