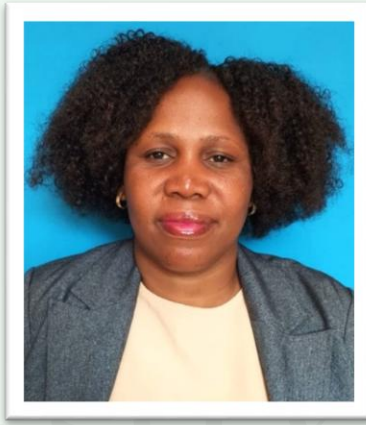
Dr. Reuben Safari Sungwa
