**The Second Major-Application Window for Applicants
2019/2020 Admission Cycle**

The University of Dodoma (UDOM) invites applications from suitably qualified candidates for admission into its various Undergraduate Degree and Non-Degree Programmes (Certificate and Diploma) for the academic year 2019/2020, under the DIRECT, EQUIVALENT & RPL Qualification modes. The **SECOND** window for application is open from 21st August, 2019 to 29th August, 2019. Candidates interested to pursue degree and non-degree programmes at UDOM should apply directly to The University of Dodoma through the UDOM online Admission System (UOAS) available at <https://application.udom.ac.tz>. For applicants who were not successful during the FIRST round are allowed to re-apply in this window. Details of the degree and non-degree programmes and application procedures can be accessed at the University of Dodoma website: www.udom.ac.tz. All successful applicants are guaranteed of affordable fees and on-campus accommodation with excellent learning environment.

1. Minimum Entrance Requirements

A candidate shall be deemed eligible for consideration for admission to an undergraduate degree programme of the University if the candidate has obtained:

A.	Completed A-Level studies before 2014	Two principal passes with a total of 4.0 points from Two Subjects defining the admission into the respective programme (where A = 5; B = 4; C= 3; D = 2; E = 1).
B.	Completed A-Level studies in 2014 and 2015	Two principal passes (Two Cs) with a total of 4.0 points from Two Subjects defining the admission into the respective programme (where A = 5; B+ = 4; B = 3; C= 2; D = 1). Grade 'D' is not considered as a principal pass in this category.
C.	Completed A –Level studies from 2016	Two principal passes with a total of 4.0 points from Two Subjects defining the admission into the respective programme (where A = 5; B = 4; C= 3; D = 2; E = 1).
D.	Recognition of Prior Learning qualification	B+ Grade: where A=75-100, B+=65-74, B=50-64, C=40-49, D=35-39, F=0-38
E.	Equivalent applicants	At least four O’-Level passes (Ds and above) or NVA Level III with less than four O’-Level passes or equivalent foreign i) At least a GPA of 3.0 for Ordinary Diploma (NTA Level 6); OR ii) Average of C for Full Technician Certificate (FTC) (where A=5, B=4, C=3, and D=2 points); OR iii) Average of ‘B’ Grade for Diploma in Teacher Education; OR iv) Average of ‘B’ Grade for Health-related awards such as Clinical Medicine and others; OR v) A Distinction for unclassified diplomas and certificates. vi) Upper Second Class for classified non-NTA diplomas.
F.	Doctor of Medicine (MD/MBBS)	Three principal passes in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology with minimum entry of 8 points. Whereby one must have at least C grade in Chemistry and Biology and at least D grade in Physics.
G.	Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN)	Three principal passes in Chemistry, Biology and either Physics or Mathematics or Nutrition with a Minimum of 6 points. Whereby one must have at least C grade in Chemistry and at least D grade in Biology and E grade in Physics or Mathematics or Nutrition.
